## Resource Net Radio Operator Tracker Instructions

**HEADER:** 

Incident Name/Number This is assigned by Incident Command. Leave blank if necessary.

Start Date Give the date the resource net opened, or the date you assumed net control at a new

location. Use three letters for month, not digits. EX: 01JAN2014 or JAN 01, 2014

Time The time the resource net opened, or the time you assumed net control at a new

location. Use 24 hour clock and local time.

End Date Give the date the resource net closed, or the date you transferred net control to an

operator at a different location.

Time Give the time the resource net closed, or the date you transferred net control to an

operator at a different location. Use 24 hour clock and local time.

Net Control Station Name Enter the Name of the Net Control who started the net or this page of the net.

Call Sign Enter the Call Sign of the Net Control who started the net or this page of the net.

**BODY**: There are two lines for each operator who checks in.

<u>First Line</u> (If you are the first to open the net, this line is for you.)

Check In Time Enter the time the operator checks into the Resource Net.

Call Sign Operator's call Sign

Name Operator's Name

Deployed to: Location or Served Agency, and tactical Call Sign

Dispatch Time Time operator was told to deploy. Use 24 hour clock and local time.

Arrival Time Time operator checks in to say they have arrived.

Disposition This will be either "Redeploy" or "Home." If the operator redeploys, start a new entry on

a new line. In a real incident, the operator should check in again when he reaches home

safely and that time is entered after the word "Home." We do not do this for drills.

<u>Second Line</u> Operator info such as availability and ability to deploy, equipment, transportation, etc.

final page count.

If you turn the Resource Net Control to a new operator at your location, hand them this record and they will continue it. Change of net control operator will be noted in the Unit Log and/or Communication Log. If the new net control operator is not at the same location, relay the information on this form and the new NC will start his own tracker form. Then enter end time and final page numbers on your record and give it to the EC as soon as possible.
