Please Copy	Start writing the next words I say	Follows an ICS 213. <b>Please Copy</b> Incident Cascadia rising...
End	End of message	Love break Mom and Dad <b>End</b>
# to Follow	I have # more message for you to copy	End, <b>Two to Follow</b>
Roger	I am sure I have the message copied correctly	<b>Roger</b> , KK7DEB
Go Next	I am ready to copy your next message	Roger <b>Go Next</b>

### ARRL Radiogram Preamble

(Do not use prowords or name the fields in the top header line.)

Amateur Call	Preceeds a callsign in the address	John Doe <b>Amateur Call</b> KI7ABC
Zip Figures	Preceeds the zip code in the address	Portland, Oregon <b>Zip Figures</b> 97210
Phone Figures	Preceeds the phone number in the address	<b>Phone Figures</b> 503 318 1333

### Message Text in ICS 213 and ARRL Radiograms

Break	Used as quotation marks around text of message	Phone Figures 503-318-1333 <b>Break</b> Hi Mom... ... Love <b>Break</b> Jenny
I spell	I will spell phonetically the last word I said	My name is Eliza <b>I Spell</b> Echo Lima India... (Also used to spell names in address)
Initials	the next thing I say will be an abbreviation or acronym	Multnomah <b>Initials</b> Charlie Oscar <b>Initials</b> Alpha Romeo Echo Sierra
Mixed Group	The next thing I say will be a combination of letters and digits	My new callsign is <b>Mixed Group</b> Whiskey Seven Echo Lima India
Mixed Group Figures	The next thing I say will be a combination of letters and digits, beginning with digits	My license plate is <b>Mixed Group Figures</b> One Two Three Alpha Bravo Charlie

### Corrections and Fills

Always give fills and repeats phonetically

I Say Again	to immediately correct a mistake. Say the last correct word, then the corrected word	Jean Simpson <b>I Say Again</b> Jean Simmonds
Word After	Please repeat the word after ____	Fills, please. <b>Word After</b> "new"
All Between	Please repeat everything between ____ and ____	<b>All Between</b> "new" and "love"
Correction	I need to correct something previously given	<b>Correction.</b> Word after "new" is "callsign"
Confirm	Do I have this correctly? Yes, you do	<b>Confirm</b> zip figures 97210? <b>Confirm</b>
