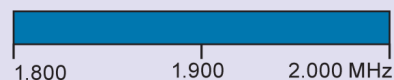

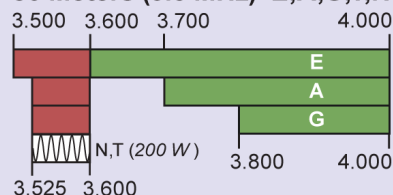

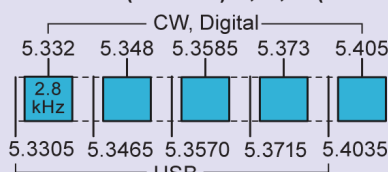

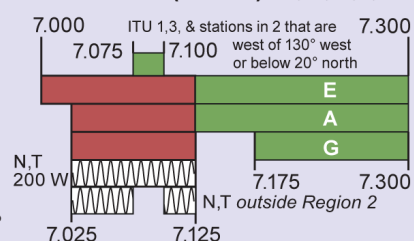


60 Meters (5.3 MHz) E, A, G (100 W)

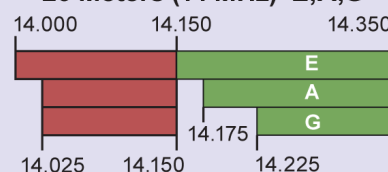

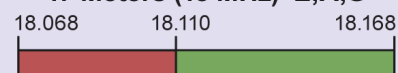
30 Meters (10.1 MHz) E,A,G



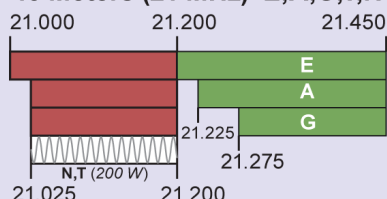
20 Meters (14 MHz) E,A,G



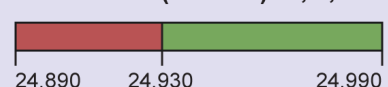

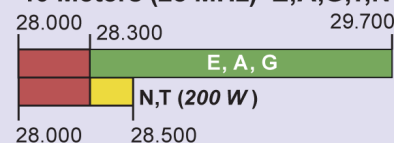

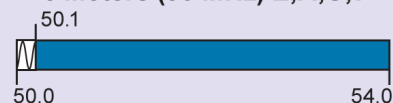


10 Meters (28 MHz) E,A,G,T,N

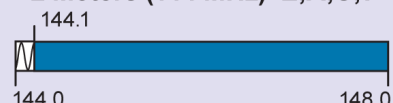

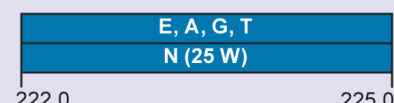
6 Meters (50 MHz) E,A,G,T



2 Meters (144 MHz) E,A,G,T

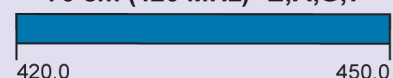


1.25 Meters (222 MHz) E,A,G,T,N

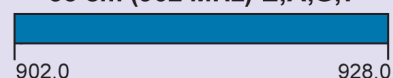

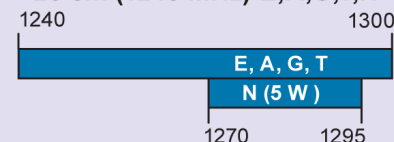
